These Minutes record that a resolution from the floor to review and approve aspects of the Annual Subscription effective 1st October 2006 was passed as below.

- That the quarterly usage vouchers offered to Town Members be withdrawn
- That the subscription for Senior Members as at 1st April 2000 be adjusted to 25% of the Town Membership
- That the subscription for Retired Members as at 1st April 2000 be adjusted to 50% of the Town Membership
- That the subscription for Country Members be adjusted to 50% of the Town Membership
- That the subscription for Overseas Members be adjusted to 50% of the Town Membership

In the meantime it is "business as usual" at your Club and yet again I urge Members to take full advantage of the Club's facilities. We do need to increase Member usage and we are actively looking at ways by

which we can encourage Members to, in particular, partake of the Club's dining facilities.
